Introduction

We take pride in the achievement of our students. Our year 11 students have joined us throughout the year and not only have the majority of student's attendance improved so has the engagement in learning. In a challenging GCSE environment following the national pandemic our students rose to the challenge and worked in partnership with us to succeed.

GCSE Results Headlines – End of Key Stage 4

- 100% achieved at least one accreditation
- 91% achieved a grade 1 – 9 in English, Maths or Combined Science
- 24% achieved level 2 -3 in Maths
- 66% achieved level 2 in Combined Science
- 66% achieved level 2+ in English Language
- 25% achieved level 3 in English Language
- 100% achieved between level 5-7 in Art
- 91% also achieved a Functional Skills accreditation in English

Spelling Age Assessment

- Spelling tests are carried out upon entry and thereafter once every term using the NGST Assessments
- The average spelling age ranges from 8 – 13+ years across Key Stage 3 & 4
- On average, students made 5 months spelling progress in one term
